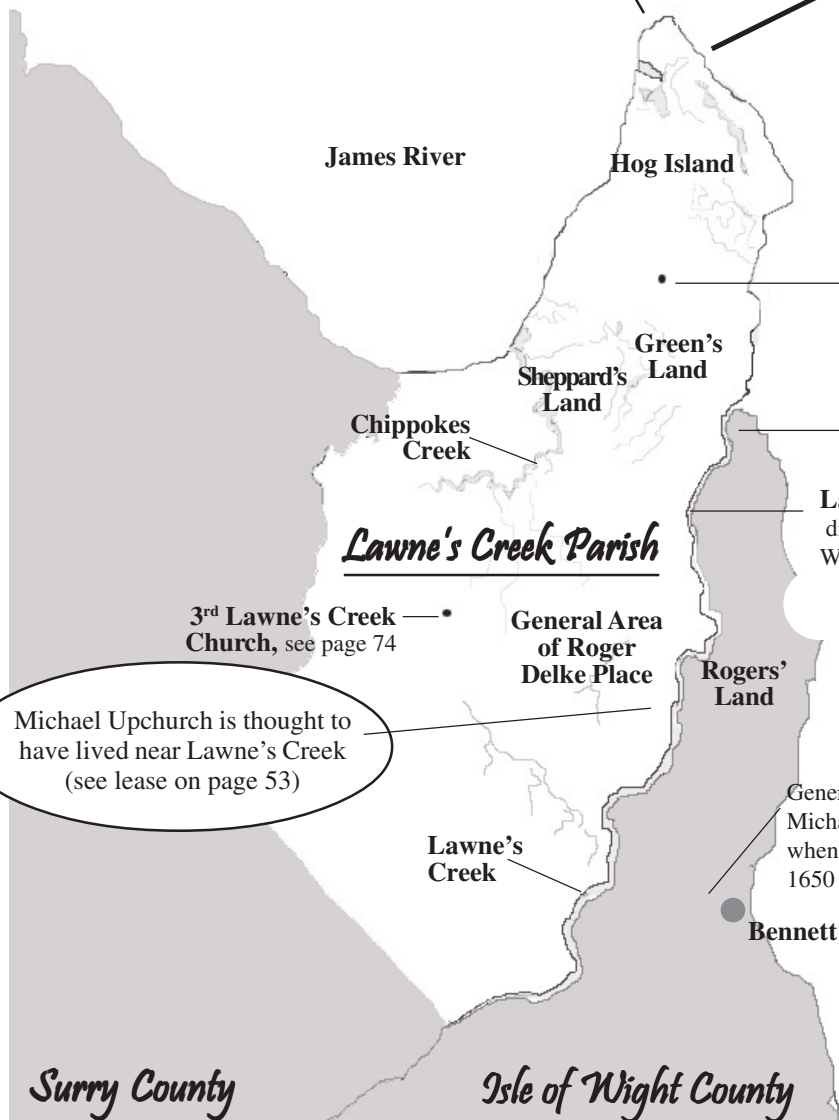
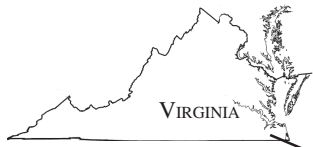
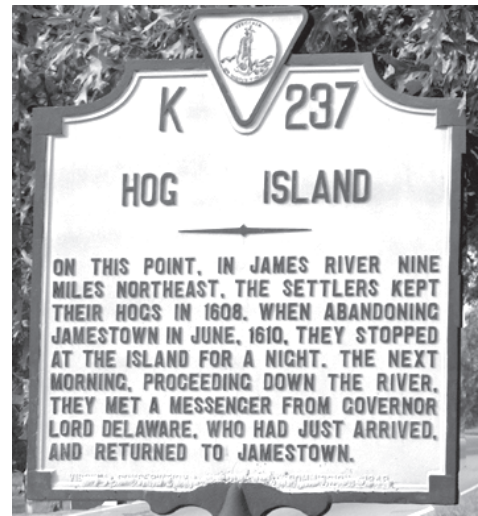


Lawne's Creek Parish
